#### **PROSPECTUS**

The Council, located in the centre of Koraput, the district headquarters, is a registered body under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 bearing Registration No. 712 / 82 of 1991-92 dated the 28. 03. 92 and is engaged in study, research and publication centering on tribal life and cultures.

The campus provides a serene atmosphere for study and research. The Library has 8000 number of reference books & Journals and subscribes to 14 Journals. It is situated by the side of a rich tribal museum, depicting various aspects of tribal life and culture. The Council of Analytical Tribal Studies has received permission from the Higher Education Department of Govt. of Odisha, to start M.A. class in 'Tribal Studies' from 2014-15 session.

#### Eligibility for admission into M.A. in Tribal Studies:

Any candidate who has passed the degree examination in Arts / Science / Commerce / Agricultural Science with a minimum of 45% of marks in aggregate or in Honours from Berhampur University or other Universities / Institutions which is recognized as Equivalent thereto by Berhampur University shall be eligible for consideration for admission.

In respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes a minimum of 40% of marks in aggregate or in Hons. subject shall be eligible for consideration of admission.

#### Other Criteria:

- 1. For candidates who have passed more than one qualifying examination, the examination in which they have secured the highest marks shall be considered for determining eligibility.
- 2. A Master Degree holder of Berhampur or any other University in India or abroad shall not be considered for admission in M.A. class in 'Tribal Studies'.

#### 3. Preparation of Merit List of Eligible Candidates:
